GENEALOGY NUMBERING SYSTEM

There can be considerable confusion with so many families. To ease the confusion, a numbering system is used throughout the entire document. The leading digits indicate the parent's number, and the last digit indicates the placement in the family (i.e. a:3.2 is the second child of the a:3 parents).

First name may have been spelled Riesz or Riez

Born into the Catholic faith

Joined the Lutheran faith (perhaps because wife was Lutheran)

Reverted to Catholicism on his death bed

Migrated to Alsace-Lorraine where he owned and operated a flour mill

Later moved to Sabara, Russia

Had several brothers who migrated to North America circa 1820 one of whom settled at New Liberty, Logan County, Ohio

Somewhere along the way, the Ries families joined the Mennonite faith

oo Elisabeth Lichty, circa 1795

Was a widow of Johann Lichty. Brought a child Maria Lichty into the marriage.

Maria was born 1790, died 1840, and married P Heinrich Moses or Phillip Prieheim Ini 1809.
